

## CAPT. MICHAEL HAYES, PARK EMPLOYEE 53 YRS., IS NAMED POLICE CHIEF

Capt. Michael C. Hayes, 1540 East 67th place, 75 years old, the oldest member of the south park police force and an employé of the Chicago parks for more than fifty-three years, yesterday was named the first chief of police of the Chicago park district by the park board. Hayes plays golf regularly at the Jackson park course, with an average score between 95 and 100. He is also an enthusiastic bowler.

Since the consolidation of the park districts George T. Donoghue, general superintendent, has acted in the capacity of chief of police. Donoghue explained that due to civil service regulations Capt. Hayes will be officially designated as "acting chief of police." Lieut. Edward Redd, also of the south division, who formerly was in charge of police at A Century of Progress, was named acting captain of the south division to succeed Capt. Hayes.

Capt. Hayes entered the service of the south park board as a boat attendant, later joining the police force.
