One in Each Region

Three new combination ambulance and police squad cars will be placed in service this morning by the Cook county highway police department, according to Herbert H. Burns, chief of the department. The cars are radio equipped, as are other squad cars, but in addition provide space for a stretcher. Chief Burns said yesterday one car would be assigned to the Morton Grove police station, one to Willow Springs, and one to Homewood.
