POLICE CADET APPLICATIONS NOW TOTAL 613

Three hundred of 613 applications for the police cadet program were accepted yesterday for the first 100 jobs.

A total of 159 applicants took preliminary tests yesterday at the police academy, 729 O'Brien

st., and the remainder will take the tests Saturday. Cadets will do clerical police work 40 hours a week, arranged to fit their college studies of 6 semester hours.

The cadets, all 17 or 18 years old, can take the police examination and join the force when they become 21. Cadet salaries will range from \$4,074 to \$4,710 after 30 months.
