
68 YOUTHS GO IN TRAINING AS POLICE CADETS

Sixty-eight high school graduates between the ages of 18 and 21 began training yesterday as police cadets.

The trainees will spend six weeks in the police academy, learning to make reports and to provide public information services.

The cadets are selected on the condition that they go to college and are eligible to take the patrolman's civil service examination when they become 21 years old. This group makes a total of 166 cadets in the cadet program.
